



29th ESTONIAN OPEN MASTERS CHAMPIONSHIPS INVITATION 2018

- The Championships will be held on **8th of December 2018** in Nõmme swimming pool (Vabaduse pst. 156, Tallinn <http://tsh.ee/eng/924/>)
- The competition will be organized by Estonian Swimming Federation in collaboration with Meisterujumise U-Klubi (contact Kristiina Arusoo, +372 56656831)
- The participants must have a valid swimmers license of any national swimming federation affiliated to FINA.
- The competition will be swum in one session in a 25 m indoor pool with 6 lanes.
- Electronic time-keeping shall be used.
- Entries should be sent at latest on **28th of November 2018** to e-mail u-klubi@u-klubi.com
Please use the official entry form or Lenex file. All entries should be sent through clubs!
- Entry fees: 25-64 year olds - 8 euros per start or 30 euros for all 5 events
65+ year olds - 5 euros per start or 20 euros for all 5 events
- Entry fees should be paid at latest on 3rd of December to bank account of EESTI UJUMISLIIT

As explanation please use: MASTERS. Swimmers from countries with other currency then euro can pay their entry fees before the competition in cash.
- FINA rules and the general competition rules of Estonian Swimming Federation for 2018 / 19 season are valid.

Events:

- 1 / 2 50 m Freestyle W/ M
- 3 / 4 50 m Breaststroke W/ M
- 5 / 6 50 m Butterfly W/ M
- 7 / 8 50 m Backstroke W/ M
- 9 / 10 100 m Ind. Medley W/ M

Schedule:

Start of the competitions at 12:00, warm-up at 11:00-11:50. Race-office is open from 10:45.
Heats will be formed in the basis of entry times, regardless of age-groups.
After each event there will be approx. 10 min brake.



Age groups:

FINA masters age groups (swimmers with year of birth 1993 and earlier). The age of competitor is determined by December 31st 2018.

Awards:

Diplomas will be given to all swimmers.

Medals will be awarded to swimmers placed in TOP 3 within one`s age group at least in one event (one medal per person).

Special ranking using age coefficient will be calculated for “Supermaster” title (50 m in all disciplines +100 m IM).

The first 6 men and women in Supermaster ranking will be awarded with medals.

The competitions are also the final stage of Baltic Supermasters Cup. 6 best men and women will be awarded in that category.

Awards ceremony will be held 30 min after the competition on the 2nd floor of Nõmme swimming pool.
